

## B15 improvement works



**In the improvement works on federal highway B15 in Neufahrn, Lower Bavaria, carried out by Fahrner Bauunternehmung GmbH from Mallersdorf-Pfaffenberg, the Bergmann 2060 R PLUS was in action. The wheel dumper with a payload of 6 tonnes performed valuable work here during the two-month construction period, removing soil from the very small construction site.**

The construction work from August to October not only included the repair of pavements on the main Neufahrn through-road, but also the extension and renewal of the upper layers of asphalt.

#### **Powerful dumper for small construction sites**

"Construction sites in the public field generally have very little space, and these are very challenging," is how foreman Manuel Klenner sums up the situation during the B15 improvement works in the Neufahrn region. The employee of Fahrner Bauunternehmung GmbH from Mallersdorf-Pfaffenberg is,

like all of his colleagues, amazed by the dumper's properties: "The 2060 R PLUS is a very robust and flexible machine that really impressed us all," says Klenner. The dumper with a round tipping dumper body was especially impressive when it came to the temporary storage of soil and the sand back-filling of the pavement, thanks to its high torque and off-road capability.

#### **Useful features for real advantages**

What is it specifically that makes the Bergmann dumper 2060 R PLUS the "construction company favourite"? Without a doubt, the vehicle weighing 4,045 kg scores points for its compact design combined with its manoeuvrability. On top of this is the safe driver access at the rear, outside of the danger zone, and the excellent field of vision due to the round tipping dumper body. When the work is done, the next project awaits, and the 2060 continues its flexible and efficient performance on its journey to the next construction site: the weather roof is simply lowered and the dumper transported on a simple lorry. "That's sophisticated, superior quality, made in Germany," says Manuel Klenner.
